Must have 2 years industry experience after having completed a minimum level 3 NVQ or advanced craft qualification in carpentry & joinery with up-to-date CPD	Experience of marking and grading assessments
Hold or be working towards an independent assessor qualification e.g. A1	
Have a sound, in depth knowledge of, and uphold the integrity of, the sector's NOS and the assessment strategy

<p>Possession of a relevant NVQ/SVQ level 3 or vocationally related qualification</p>	
<p>Hold, or are working towards, a qualification as listed within '<b>Assessing and Assuring Quality of Assessment</b>', either in the Qualifications and Credit Framework (QCF), or the Scottish Credit and Qualifications Framework (SCQF):</p> <p><b>for example</b>, qualifications include A1, D32/33. Holders of A1 and D32/33 must assess the reviewed National Occupational Standards (NOS) for Learning and Development.</p>
