Must hold a recognised current workplace assessment qualification.	
Appropriate workplace assessment qualification recognised are: Level 3 Award in Assessing Competency in the Work Environment. Level 3 Certificate in Assessing Vocational Achievement.	
A1, D32, D33 can be accepted, however assessors who hold these qualifications will need to demonstrate CPD evidence to current standards.	
Must be able to evidence relevant and up to date CPD, which is related directly to the standard and industry, not general CPD.	
Occupationally competent with current experience in the apprenticeship's discipline they intend to assess.	
Have current, relevant occupational expertise and knowledge, at the relevant level of the occupational area(s) they are assessing, which has been gained through 'hands on' experience in the industry.
