Essential	Desirable
Up-to-date, relevant, and broad experience of working in one or more of the industry areas industries, including current knowledge of working practices, legislation and policy within the sector for this apprenticeship standard.	Experience of marking and grading assessments
Must have at least three years' work experience in the sector and at least at the same level as the apprenticeship.
