Essential	Desirable
Up-to-date, relevant, and broad experience of working in the occupational area of the apprenticeship standard Including practical and current knowledge of working practices which reflect the whole standard content.	Experience of preparing for and presenting to a target audience
Comprehensive, verifiable experience of plastering i.e. three years or more experience in the sector.	Experience of marking and grading assessments
Recent relevant experience of the occupation/sector at least a level above that of the apprentice i.e. worked in the sector in the last three years or can demonstrate current knowledge and skills developed through continued professional development. Must be competent to assess the content of the standard for either or both Solid Plasterer / Fibrous Plasterer	
A competent plasterer with sufficient and current industry experience to assess the apprenticeship standard	
Qualified to at least level 3 or equivalent in plastering	
Hold or be working towards an independent assessor qualification e.g. A1	
Must be able to evidence relevant and up to date CPD, which is related directly to the standard and industry, not general CPD

 Understanding of apprenticeship standards, with specific knowledge about the relevant industry area Experience of producing clear, accurate and concise written reports.
